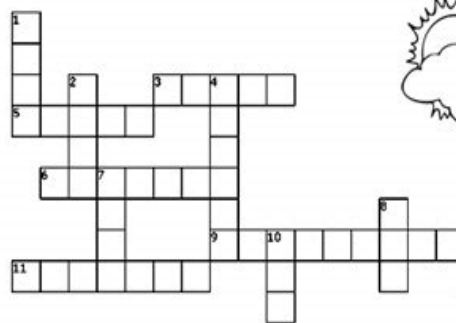
you think God might be saying to you and your prayers to God about what you have studied. This was the instruction in a Study Bible. Consider investing in one. A good study Bible can help you on your journey
